The following summarizes response actions completed at the above-referenced site for the period September 1, 2014 through September 30, 2014, as well as planned activities.

SITE ACTIVITIES PERFORMED

- Performed Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations, if present.
- Prepared a summary of the soil gas sampling event for location SG-105S completed in July 2014. This summary was submitted to the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM) on October 1, 2014. FUTURE RESPONSE ACTION WORK/SCHEDULE

- Continue quarterly NAPL monitoring and recovery. The next event is scheduled for October 2014.
- The annual groundwater sampling round and quarterly sampling of soil gas location SG-105S will also be completed in October 2014.
- Continue Site visits to document security conditions and sheen observations.
- Removal of materials and debris from three Site buildings starting on October 6, 2014. We currently expect this work will take approximately 2 weeks to complete and will also include limited brush cutting and clearing around the buildings. No soil will be disturbed as part of this activity.
