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### SITE ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED

- Complete bi-monthly Site observation walk during the week of October 16<sup>th</sup>.
- Continue performance of limited design investigations (LDI). As described in the *Limited Design Investigation Work Plan* (LDI Work Plan) submitted to RIDEM on June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017, these investigations include performance of test pits, soil borings and the collection and analysis of soil samples. The results of the LDI will be used to facilitate development of the site remedy design. A public notification regarding the LDI activities was issued on August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017. GZA is performing full time oversight to manage and document the LDI activities and conduct air quality monitoring consistent with the project-specific Air Quality Monitoring Plan. Air monitoring data is posted on a weekly basis on the Tidewater website (tidewatersite.com) and the bulletin boards located at the end of Tidewater Street and Bowles Court. To date, no exceedances of specified air monitoring limits have been detected.
