ELECTRICAL SUBSTATION AND SWITCHING STATION (PAWTUCKET NO. 1 STATION)

- The Tidewater Station serves approximately 32,300 customers in Pawtucket, including the downtown of the City of Pawtucket.
- The station is designed to convert electricity from one voltage to another, with the transmission lines carrying a voltage of 115 kV to the substation. The station then reduces the voltage to a level suitable for local distribution.
- Significant upgrades have been made to the Pawtucket No.1 Station to ensure reliable and safe service to the community:
 - Regular equipment maintenance and replacement work
 - Replacement and installation of new conduit and breakers
